## SECTION 4: First aid measures

### 4.1 Description of first aid measures

#### After inhalation:

Move to fresh air. Seek medical advice if cough, shortness of breath or other respiratory problems occur.

#### After skin contact:

Remove all contaminated clothes and footwear immediately unless stuck to skin. Wash immediately with plenty of soap and water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

#### After eye contact:

Rinse immediately with plenty of water, also under the eyelids, for at least 15 minutes. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

#### After swallowing:

Do not induce vomiting. If victim is conscious, rinse mouth with a small amount of water. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Consult a doctor.

Immediate effects can be expected after short-term exposure.

Take victim to a doctor if irritation persists.

### 5.1. Extinguishing media

#### Suitable extinguishing media:

Water, water fog, foam, carbon dioxide, dry chemical. Suitable extinguishing media for the surrounding fire should be used. Use water spray to cool containers.
